- livestock carrier
- luton van
- minibus
- · MPV (multi-purpose vehicle)
- · panel van
- · specially fitted van
- · special mobile unit
- · van with side windows

If the vehicle's body type as shown on your V5C (log book) is not one of the above, do not send in your application, as DVLA will not process it.
